Meat Judging

Since we have not had judging teams competing in the Soils or Range contests for the past several years, I did not assign anyone to these contests. However, if we have participants, the agent or volunteer sending the team will become the Superintendent for that respective contest.

If you would like to trade judging contest assignments with another agent or a trained adult volunteer, please send written notification to Dr. Montza Williams and Ms. Shelia Lewis at least two weeks prior to the contest.

The above mentioned judging contests are held in College Station on the specified date. As more information is made available it will be distributed to you. Further information usually comes via e-mail and will be forwarded to you for dissemination to your 4-H families.

The competition teams should be named during early registration but must be designated before the members register on site. Please make sure that your members are aware of the team on which they are to participate before they register on site.

If there are no teams participating in the judging event for which assignments have been made, agents will be notified and will not be expected to travel to College Station for that specific assignment.

Registration Process

Registration for all contests will be conducted via 4-H Connect. The link can be found at the Texas 4-H home page http://texas4-h.tamu.edu/ and is located in the top black row as 4-H Connect. Each participant must set up a profile, be approved by the county office, and then register for the event of their choice.

→ Payments for entry in an event are due **before** the event. Entries must show as paid on 4-H Connect by Noon the Friday before the event. Late payments will result in the 4-H member not being able to place or receive awards in the event. However, the member may still participate.
