Part 1: Robot course (75% of total score): Rounds will be 1-3 minutes long. The Texas 4-H Round Up rules will be followed with the following changes: Participation rule # 2 and 3 is modified to allow Junior members to compete in the competition. Participation rule # 5 will be modified to say that registration is limited to 8 teams in each division on a first-come, first served basis. Part 2: Presentation (25% of total score): There will be a 3-5 minute **team** presentation. Every team member must participate in the presentation. In the presentation, students must briefly introduce themselves, state problems encountered, how problems were resolved, and what the team learned. Team presentations should be limited to **total** of 5 minutes, but must not be any shorter than 3 minutes.
