District 5 Event Guidelines

Entry Requirements

- Enter individually on 4HOnline beginning December 4, 2020 at https://v2.4honline.com
- Contest Fee \$12 per contestant
 - ✓ Food Challenge is a team event (3 or 4-member team)
 - ✓ When registering, ALL team members must be listed in 4HOnline.
- Late Entry Fee \$25 per contestant

District Deadlines

- Entry to 4HOnline and entry materials by March 16, 2021
- Soft due date for agents: March 17, 2021 (only to be used for corrections to entries)
- Late entry **March 18-20, 2021** (late fees apply)

Entry Divisions (grade by August 31, 2020)

Junior Grades 3, 4, and 5Intermediate Grades 6, 7, and 8

• Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12

Team Entries Per County

- Each county may submit FIVE teams per age division.
- A total of 15 team entries per county may be submitted for the district contest.
- Teams may not include members in different age divisions.

Special Accommodations

• Any competitor who requires auxiliary aids or special accommodations must contact the District office at least 2 weeks before the competition or note such needs when registering on 4HOnline.

Awards

- Placing will be announced the week following the contest.
- Awards for each age division will be mailed to local county Extension offices for presentation.
 - o 1st 4th places will be presented a rosette and an award to be determined by committee.
- Entry via 4HOnline gives permission to the District office to use the participant's name, photograph, and/or recipe as needed for marketing and promotion purposes.
