District 5 Event Guidelines

2021 Fashion Extravaganza Theme: Reinventing Fashion with History

See how history shaped fashion through the decades; from the roaring 20's to the groovy 70's, from the classic 30's to the vibrant 80s and the fashion "mash-up" during the 2010's. Each decade has its own style, look at the events, music and politics that influenced design during the different decades. This year reinvent fashion by the events that happened in a previous decade or a decade yet to come.

Entry Requirements

- Enter individually on 4HOnline beginning March 8, 2021 at <https://texas.4honline.com>
- Contest Fee - \$10 per contestant
- Late Entry Fee - \$25 per contestant
- Fashion Extravaganza Contests
 - ✓ Fashion Show
 - ✓ Storyboard
 - ✓ Fabric and Textile Creations

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- ✓ Duds to Dazzle (Team event) - When registering, ALL members must be listed in 4HOnline.

District Deadlines

- Registration in 4HOnline, entry materials, and approval at county-level by **April 14, 2021**
- Soft due date for agents: **April 15, 2021** (only to be used for corrections to entries)
- Late entry – **April 16-21, 2021** (late fees apply)

Entry Divisions (grade by August 31, 2020)

- Junior Grades 3, 4, and 5
- Intermediate Grades 6, 7, and 8
- Senior Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12

Entries Per County

- **Fashion Show:** Each county may enter one contestant per age division per category.
- **Duds to Dazzle:** Each county may enter five teams per age division. No mixed age division teams.
- **Storyboard:** Each county may enter one contestant per age division per category.
- **Fabric and Textile Creations:** Each contestant may enter one creation with no limits to number of entries per county.

Entry Materials

- Completed entry materials that pertain to each contest should be submitted to the district office via email to carolyn.walton@ag.tamu.edu by **April 15, 2021**.

Score Card

- Complete one score card per Fashion Extravaganza contestant or team with name of county (please type).

Duds to Dazzle Team Roster

- Complete one team roster per Duds to Dazzle team with name of county (please type).
- Be sure to be creative with your team name as each will be entered into a Creative Team Name contest!

Fashion Show Paperwork

- Fashion Show paperwork will be required at the District contest to be in alignment with State Roundup. This paperwork is due by **April 15, 2021** to Carolyn Walton.

Storyboard and Fabric & Textile Creations Labels

- Storyboards must be labeled when presented at the Check-in Desk. A storyboard label is attached in this to be copied email for contestant use (not required in advance to District office).





- Fabric & Textile Creations must be labeled when presented at the Check-in Desk. A label is attached in this email to be copied for contestant use (not required in advance to District office).

Social Distancing (this information may be modified if requirements change before contest date of May 1, 2021)

To host this 4-H event, all persons entering any of the contest buildings must comply with the following Texas A&M AgriLife social distance guidelines:

- Persons aged 10 years and above wear a facemask (participants will be permitted to remove for judging interviews as long as he/she maintains 6-foot distance).
- Maintain social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet.
- Seating for Fashion Show and Awards will be designated on each row of chairs in the sanctuary. Be sure to skip chairs if sitting by someone outside your household.
- Buildings, tables, and chairs will be sanitized before and after use.
- Each person entering any of the contest buildings must submit a completed COVID-19 screening form (see attached).

Tentative Schedule (Duds to Dazzle and Fashion Show Judging)

- Schedule may be modified based upon number of Fashion Extravaganza contestants.
- Final schedule will be posted on the district website at D54-H.tamu.edu and on the district Facebook page at [District 5 Texas 4-H](#)
- Duds to Dazzle contestants are scheduled to check in to their contest room between 12:15 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. Orientation will begin at 12:30 p.m.
- Fashion Show contestants are scheduled to check into their interview rooms at 1:00 p.m.
- Fashion Show rehearsal will take place after all judging is complete. To participate in the Fashion Show, contestant must be present for the rehearsal.
- Participants in both Duds to Dazzle and Fashion Show will check into the Duds to Dazzle contest first. Fashion Show interviews for these contestants will be coordinated so that he/she can participate in both contests.

Drop-off and Go Contest Schedule (Storyboard and Fabric & Textile Creations)

- Drop-off your Storyboard and/or Fabric & Textile Creation at the Check-in Desk located in the Children's Building foyer.
- Contestants or a designated person remitting entries for judging, will need to bring their item between 8:00 am and 12:00 pm. Items will be judged beginning at 1:00 pm.
- Contestant or a designated person identified at check-in must pick up their entry items between 3:30 and 4:00 p.m. from the Check-in Desk.
- Items not picked-up at this time will be returned to the district office for pick-up by county agents.

Contest Committee Members

- Committee members will need to check-in at the **Help Desk** located in the Guest Services booth just inside the doors of the children's building.

Awards

- Presentation of awards for each age division will be held in the sanctuary following tabulation of results.
 - 1st – 3rd places will receive a rosette and a prize to be determined by committee.
 - High point teams in Duds to Dazzle will be presented prizes in each age division.
 - The Duds to Dazzle committee is hosting a “creative team name” competition. A prize will be presented the most creative team name at the award ceremony.
- Entry via 4HOnline gives permission to the District office to use the participant's name and/or photograph as needed for marketing and promotion purposes.

Fashion Contests that Qualify for State Roundup



- Fashion Show (qualifying Seniors).
- Duds to Dazzle (qualifying Senior teams).
- Storyboards (invitational contest for Seniors only – digital Storyboard format to be uploaded via 4-HOnline between April 1-15, 2021.)
- Fabric & Textile Creations – A District 5 only event.

Judges
